- A clear description of all processes, interventions and comparisons. Generic drug names should generally be used.

Statistical analysis

The type of statistical analysis used, including a power calculation if appropriate.

Results

In this section, should be include the findings of the study including, if appropriate, results of statistical analysis

which must be included either in the text or as tables, graphs, flow charts figures and all necessary pictures. 10.....

Discussion

In this section should be discuss the implications of the findings in context of existing research and highlight limitations of the study.

Conclusions

In this section should state clearly the main conclusions and provide an explanation of the importance and relevance of the study.
